Station of Bahá'u'lláh

Dear Friends,

The Universal House of Justice in its message of Ridvan 1990 to the bahá'ís of the World wrote: "Beloved Friends: Merely two years separate us from the conclusion of the Six Year Plan and the beginning of Ridvan 1992 of the Holy Year, that special time when we shall pause to appreciate the tumultuous record of events which will have brought us to the Centenary of the Ascension of Bahá'u'lláh and to reflect with due solemnity upon the redemptive purpose of the life of the most precious Being ever to have drawn breath on this planet." As we prepare to embrace the Holy Year study of the life and station of Bahá'u'lláh should be among high priorities of our Bahá'í life.

A complete and thorough understanding of the majesty and grandeur of the station of Baha'u'llah is beyond the reach of the holy ones let alone ordinary human beings. Yet, only through Him man can know God. Shoghi Effendi in ¹The Dispensation of Baha'u'llah writes: "To strive to obtain a more adequate understanding of the significance of Bahá'u'lláh stupendous Revelation must, it is my unalterable conviction, remain the first obligation and the object of the constant endeavor of each one of its loyal adherents. An exact and thorough comprehension of so vast a system, so sublime a revelation, so sacred a trust, is for obvious reasons beyond the reach and ken of our finite minds. We can, however, and it is our bounden duty to seek to derive fresh inspiration and added sustenance as we labor for the propagation of His Faith through a clearer apprehension of the truths it enshrines and the principles on which it is based."

One approach to the study of the station of Bahá'u'llah is to look at the prophecies from previous scriptures. Some of the references to Him are: Glory of the Lord, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace, Lord of Hosts, King of Glory, Desire of all nations, Sun of Righteousness, World Savior, Shah-Bahram, Buddha of Universal Fellowship, Most Great Spirit, Tenth Avatar, Immaculate Manifestations of Krishna, Prince of this world, Comforter, Spirit of Truth, Lord of the Vineyard, Glory of God, Alpha and Omega, Great Announcement, He who conversed with Moses from the Burning Bush on Sinai, Essence of Being, Remnant of God, Lord of the visible and invisible, sole Object of all previous Revelations, and He whom God shall make manifest. Friends can refer to the monumental work of the beloved Guardian, ²God Passes By, for some of the prophecies concerning the Blessed Beauty. It is important to point out the fact that although by His appearance Baha'u'llah has fulfilled these and many other prophecies, His station is not limited to the fulfillment of any of these prophecies. For example, Baha'u'llah is the return of Imam Husayn to Shiah Islam, however this does not mean that His station is limited to the fulfillment of this prophecy.

The Master, in ³Some Answered Questions explains that the Divine Manifestations have three planes:physical station, station of rational soul, and station of the divine appearance, i.e., the Holy Spirit. Abdu'l-Baha explains that the individual reality of each Manifestation of God is distinct and unique: "...the individual reality of the Manifestations of God is a holy reality, and for that reason it is sanctified and, in that which concerns its nature and quality, is distinguished from all other things...The Divine Manifestations are so many different mirrors because they have a special individuality, but that which is reflected in the mirrors is one sun. It is clear that the reality of Christ is different from that of Moses." Two points should be emphasized in the above passage. First, the rational soul or the human reality of the Manifestation of God is a holy reality. Second, each Divine Manifestation has a different and distinct reality. concerning the Holy Reality 4'Abdu'l-Baha says "The individual realities of the Divine Manifestations have no separation from the Bounty of God and the Lordly Splendor." When we speak of the reality Baha'u'llah the intention is His holy reality and not the physical station of Mirza Husayn Ali. Some of the most illuminating statements about the station of Baha'u'llah - He Whom God shall make manifest are found in the Writing of the Babi Dispensation. The Bab in the third Vahid (section) of the chapter 15 of the Persian Bayan says that the Primal Will (that which is the first creation or emanation from God) in every Dispensation hath been and is Baha'u'llah. In every Dispensation the intermediary between God and His Manifestation has been described in a unique and distinct way: the Burning Bush to Moses, the Dove to Christ, the Angel Gabriel to Muhammad. These are different descriptions or symbols of the same reality, the Holy Spirit. Baha'u'llah, being the Most Great Spirit, in some of His Writings has stated that He has created that intermediary, the Holy Spirit. In the ⁵Suriy-i-Haykal (Surih of the Temple) Baha'u'llah states:

"The Holy Spirit Itself hath been generated through the agency of a single letter revealed by this Most Great

Spirit, if ye be of them that comprehend."

Adib Taherzadeh in the third volume of Revelation of Baha'u'llah concerning this subject writes: [In His writings, Baha'u'llah has indicated that whereas in past Dispensations the Prophets and Messengers of God received their Revelations through an intermediary, in this Dispensation the voice of God may be heard directly from the Person of Baha'u'llah. Affirming this in one of His Tablets, Baha'u'llah states that the same voice which Moses heard through the Burning Bush may be heard directly from Baha'u'llah in this Day.] This does not mean that Baha'u'llah is identifying His station with that of Godhead. As it is quite clear from numerous Writings of the Blessed Beauty, the essence of God is beyond comprehension of all, including His Manifestations. Of course the best way to understand the station of Baha'u'llah is to read and comprehend His writings directly.

Once we have had the opportunity to study the Writings of the Bab, Baha'u'llah, 'Abdu'l-Baha, and Shoghi Effendi on the station of the Blessed Beauty it will not come as a surprise to us that His is the station of the Father, the Lord of Hosts, the Creator, and not only the fulfillment of the prophecies regarding return of the previous Divine Manifestations.

In the Book of Certitude, Baha'u'llah describes two

Quranic verses, one indicating that all the Manifestations are one and the same, the other explaining that every Manifestation has a unique station. Friends can refer to The Book of Certitude and study this subject in detail.

For the remainder of this article we shall review some of the writings of this Dispensation (including those of the Bab) in light of the aforementioned statements concerning the

station of Ancient Beauty, Baha'u'llah.

First The role of the Unity Committee is to survey the needs of the community and develop programs that create a "family concept" of aid and assistance. They are specifically charged with developing a plan to provide rides to those in need of transportation to activities, to work toward unifing the community, to make Feast more spiritual and joyful. Also to welcome newly declared believers and new arrivals to the community.

Second the purpose of the social needs coordinator is to assist Baha'i individual in the Colorado Springs Community with:

-food and/or housing needs

-job search assistance

-finding and distributing household effects and furniture -initial counseling and support to community members in need

-referral to counseling and other community services

-liaison between the L.S.A. and community members involved in or thinking about a year of patience and other personal difficulties

Because of the previously mentioned goals we need to have people willing to provide the following services. -provide hospitality for those in need of short term housing

-provide food

-provide household effects and furniture

-provide transportation for taking individuals to job interviews and look at housing or other appointments
