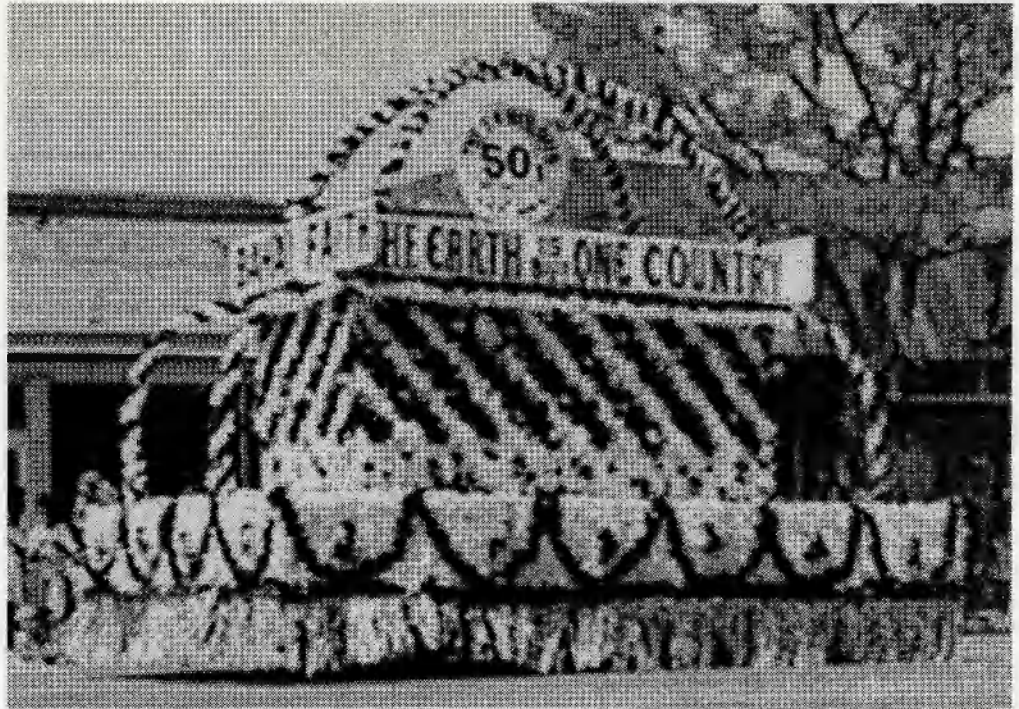
Time to renew Subscriptions
