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## Consultation Article Continued

DECIDING 2 Dangers to avoid

1. Quick resolution, before clear understanding of issue.
2. Prolonged discussion past moment of sharpest focus, potential solution becomes diluted. Practice makes better.

Make a clear and decisive announcement of the tendered decision, and then perhaps a motion to vote. From Baha'i Administration p 64 *"And, when they are dispassionate, anxious and cordial consultation, turn to God in prayer, and with earnestness and conviction and courage record their vote..."* If the consultation as truly been in a mode of prayer then the prayer may be omitted however if there has been some less than turning to God it might be advisable to have a prayer at this point. If it is apparent that everyone agrees then a vote need not be recorded. While unanimity is important it is not advisable to dwell on convincing those who do not agree.

*"The Shining spark of truth cometh forth only after the clash of differing opinions"*  
Baha'i Administration p 21.

Remember it is opinion that clashes not, people or personalities. Once an idea is expressed it belongs to the group where it may be twisted, changed, modified, be re-examined until it bears the spark of truth. Avoid clashes that bring more heat than truth. An arbitrary or tabling a decision may be necessary if the situation becomes muddled.

\* **EXECUTION** A decision made by the majority become the decision from the group not from those who voted for it. **Criticizing a decision is not permissible either in the meeting or afterwards!** Everyone is responsible to carry out the decision and make it work! Success or failure depends on the group making the decision not the individual may be asked to perform beyond his capacity.

We should not insist upon our own opinion

It is in no wise permissible for one to belittle the thoughts of another, nor permitted that anyone of the honored members object or to censure any decision that comes out of of the meeting even though that decision be not right

Stubbornness and persistence lead to discord and wrangling and the truth will remain hidden

Criticism would prevent any decision from being enforced.

Whatsoever thing is arranged if harmony and with love and purity of motive, its result is light.... if this be so regarded that assembly shall be of God...

An Important Promise = Baha'i Administration pp22-3... **should they endeavor** ....day receive a new effusion of spirit.

Note The Word "**Endeavor**"

The Healing Process Gleanings p. 97  
When disunity is present what to and not to do: Purging the problem is not advised because;

1. It assumes getting rid of the "bad". [Baha'u'llah encourages a change of Heart.]
2. It assumes that there are good Baha'is and bad Baha'is and that the good is looking for the bad or evil which is contradicted in the Baha'i Faith. 3. It creates a mindset where we begin look for the negative things in others. It prolongs disharmony because we spend time dwelling on unpleasantness.
4. Suspicious attitudes develop rather than an atmosphere of love and fellowship. It corrupts the divine purpose.
